Students in Harrison County School District participate in various classroom assessments throughout the school year. Assessments tell you about students' progress on the path to future success, whether that is the next grade or the next course. They measure what students know and can do based on learning goals for the grade or course.

High school students take four subject-area tests according to their schedule and the ACT.

- Algebra I
- English II
- Biology
- U.S. History
- ACT

Alternate Assessments

Students with Significant Cognitive Disabilities take the Mississippi Academic Assessment Program-Alternate (MAAP-A) in grades 3-8 and high school.

English Learners

Students identified as English Learners will take a English Learner Proficiency Test in grades K12. The test is given each year until students become proficient English language speakers, readers, and writers.

MAAP and LAS Links Student Reports have been sent home to students who participated in testing. These reports give the proficiency level of your student. Harrison Central High School's Mississippi Succeeds Report Card for the 2023 - 2023 school year will be posted on the Mississippi Department of Education website when scores are finalized.
